



EVENT FAQS

What are the details on the tent for our event?

The Brim will provide a staked tent (either 40x40 or 40x80, depending on your guest count and wedding date). Various layout options can be found at the following link: <https://www.twinbrospartyrentals.com/40x80-pole-tent-layouts/>. This tent will be set up by The Brim, along with Edison style string lights and your tables. If desired, it will have side panels to protect against the elements.

What if we need to get heaters?

The Brim has multiple vendors we can work with if you decide the week of that you would like to add heaters on to your tent. A rented heater with propane can often run about \$400.

What does set up look like day of?

The tent, tables, and chairs will be set up for you. We typically allow you to come set up linens and décor in your tent in the morning (prior to the official rental time which starts at 4:30). You will need to appoint someone to help direct your vendors to their locations and make sure they understand timing and the process that you want to happen. This is one reason why we recommend using our day of coordinating services. It allows us to spend some one on one time with you and gather the information on your vendors, contact them, and truly ensure that the day of your wedding goes off without a hitch. It also allows us to coordinate your ceremony as well. That way, you will worry about nothing! We've been around enough weddings to know how important this is.

Do we have the option to do a ceremony rehearsal onsite the evening before due to your other possible events?

Yes. If a wedding books that is going to be onsite the evening before, we could look into either doing the rehearsal the Thursday before, or we could do it in an alternate location (but still run it like a full rehearsal for you). Adding on the rehearsal is \$53.05 for an hour, but if you end up doing the day of coordination we throw it in for free and the coordinator is on site to run it or will help set up an alternate location if need be.

What does The Brim provide for restrooms?

The Brim agrees to provide at least one handicapped accessible restroom, and more as needed for your guest count. We will have lights for the inside, and we will keep them maintained and stocked. We will also have a handwashing station.

Who handles cleanup and what exactly does that entail?

Decorations and linens need to be removed, and trash just needs to be picked up and placed in the designated bags- we'll handle hauling that off. Any other cleanup is handled on your end, unless you would like to have the day of coordination services. If there is dangerous weather, we will recommend people leave to be safe and we will address the cleanup issues as needed later.

Where does any food prep happen? Do you provide ice?

If bartending services are added, we will handle the storage and ice for all of your drinks. We will also meet with you ahead of time to plan out your bar menu and make sure we have everything you'll need on site for that. As far as food prep/washing dishes, we don't have a designated food prep kitchen, so all of that will be something you'll want to talk through with your caterer.
